Membership Application Requirements

- Cover Letter/Email addressing the Membership Committee
 (Do not include personal information such as phone numbers/addresses, this cover letter will be seen by the general membership when getting voted on)
- 480 Hours Verification
- Resume
- Resident in the Local 210 jurisdiction for the last 18 months
- Current Standard First Aid Certificate (Encouraged but not required)

If you are interested in membership, and you have not acquired the 480 hours working under 210's jurisdiction, your letter must include a justification(s) for waiving of this requirement.

These justifications can include:

- Work in a related field
- Work in a non-unionized environment
- Education

A letter or paystub would be required from the following venues to verify the hours: Citadel Theatre/Edmonton Opera/Fringe Theatre

For film projects, please include paystubs or a letter from the production office detailing the hours worked.

Applications can be submitted to iatse210.com or in person at the local office.

Once the membership committee has reviewed your request, and the committee's recommendation has been voted on by the membership, you will be informed of the decision. If your request is accepted, you will be sent the membership application which will need to be endorsed by The International in New York. There is a \$100 fee for the membership application.

Once the application is endorsed by The International, you will be sent an email to complete the rest of the process and make the arrangements to be sworn in. The required fees to be sworn into membership is \$200 for the initiation fee and \$90 for quarterly dues.

Once you become a full member, quarterly dues payments would be required on January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1. There is a 14-day grace period before a 20-dollar late fee is assessed and you would be placed in arrears until it has been paid.
